Listed below are 12 effective events, that other congregations have used, to be involved with the Campaign. Use this as a guide for what might work best with your church family as you prayerfully consider how you may be involved. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact us. 1. Pray for Camp Luther, the mission of sharing Christ with others and the many generations that will be hearing the Gospel.
2. Support families and Camp Luther by developing your own scholarship fund/campership fund so more people can experience camp.
3. Tithe a portion of your own church's campaign to *Filled with the Spirit Campaign*.
 - a. Shepherd of the Hills, Greenville
4. Budget a monthly or annual commitment gift over a 3 or 5 year period.
 - a. Redeemer, Marquette
 - b. St. Paul, Stevens Point
 - c. St. Peter and Paul, Houghton
 - d. Faith, Appleton
 - e. St Paul, Fremont
 - i. Mission Budget
 - f. Peace, Antigo
 - i. Endowment Funds
5. Create a Giving Challenge or Matching Gift program by matching dollars contributed by members. For example, members donate \$10,000 and the church then matches it.
 - a. Our Savior, Eagle River
 - b. Rock of Ages, Minocqua
6. Create a "challenge gift" by assembly significant gifts from 3-4 individuals.
7. Conduct small group gathering events at church or in homes for potential donors, sharing the campaign video and Case for Support.
 - a. Host a Camp Luther special event, seeking 3 or 5 year commitments from individuals in your congregation.
 - i. Pilgrim, Green Bay
 - ii. Faith, Appleton
8. Conduct an annual fundraiser to sponsor children to come to Camp or to support the programs through the Outdoor Ministry Fund, examples:
 - a. Pancake Breakfast Zion, Aniwa
 - b. "Kicking for Camp", making a pledge for kick ball.
9. Hold a Camp Luther Sunday and designate all or portion of the offering to Camp Luther, example would be to collect "loose plate offerings" for Camp over a series of Sundays.
 - a. Bethlehem, Altoona - Pastor Dan Kohn
 - b. Faith, Appleton - gifts went to the Outdoor Ministry Fund
 - c. Have an, Every Kid to Camp recipient share their story. People will love to hear how their life was impacted.
10. Designate a portion of Scrip money raised for Camp.
 - a. St. Paul, Stevens Point
11. Share information on giving to camp through IRA Charitable Rollovers for those 70.5 years and above.
12. Ask groups/circles within the congregation to support the Campaign.
